Within education, children and young people may tend to underachieve, are often punished for poor behaviour or are excluded. It can appear that nothing the school does seems to work; and often the sanctions which they receive further reinforce their feelings of negativity and low self-worth.

With this introduction to Attachment, we aim to help delegates recognise the issues involved, to enable them to better support pupils with attachment difficulties, and thereby to improve attainment, behaviour and overall wellbeing for both pupils and staff.
