
Dear Parent/Carer,

COVID-19 Update – April 16th

We hope you are all managing to stay healthy and safe at home and enjoyed the sunny Easter break. I am writing today to update you on the school’s current position in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. We understand the challenges that can be presented for you at home, especially when you are unable to get outside

As you will be aware, there have been no significant changes to Government guidelines over the last couple of weeks, however, we are expecting an update this afternoon, following the next Government Cobra meeting. Obviously, we are unable to predict what announcement will be made but we are expecting that the current advice will remain in place.

We will be contacting a small group of parents today who meet the “critical worker” criteria below or have been risk assessed as requiring extra support from school at this time. We continue to follow the guidance in the flow chart below;



If you do not hear from us by the end of this week, we are expecting your child to remain at home and continue to keep in touch with your child’s class teacher as you have been doing.
