Dear Parents and Carers

I wanted to give you an update on the new Nexus satellite provision based at Wouldham Church of England Primary School.

The satellite will open in September 2018 for 6 Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils and we are consulting with parents of children who are currently at Nexus or with new parents who are looking for a Nexus placement from September 2018, for whom the satellite may be an appropriate placement.

I have attached some details which give you an overview of the children for whom the satellite may be appropriate. The children who attend the satellite will remain on the role of Nexus school but will attend the satellite on a daily basis.

Jacqui Tovey (Ex Head teacher) of Nexus is currently supporting the school with the development of the satellite and therefore is contacting parents about possible placements, however from September 2018 as the new Head teacher, I will take over responsibility for the satellite.
